

DO NOT LAUGH AT OTHERS

WITH THE NAME OF ALLAH, MOST GRACIOUS, MOST MERCIFUL.

1. We are allowed to laugh with people in a decent way, but not at people.
2. Remember, those whom we laugh at may be better than us.
3. Also know that Allah (S.W.T.) does not like us to call each other by nicknames that will hurt and embarrass a person.
4. A Muslim must never say bad things about another person, nor should she/ he speak in a manner that may injure anyone's feelings.

Listen to Sura Al- Hujarat (Ch. 49) : verse 11 :-

"O you who believe! Let not some men among you laugh at others: it may be that the (latter) are better than the (former): nor let some women laugh at others: it may be that the (latter) are better than the (former): nor defame nor be sarcastic to each other, nor call each other by nicknames: ill-seeming is a name connoting wickedness, (to be used of one) after he has believed: and those who do not stop are doing wrong."

Our beloved Nabie (S.A.W.) said:-

"Do not rejoice over the distress of another Muslim, for Allah (S.W.T.) may remove his / her distress and place you in his / her position."
