

ON SHAITAN

WITH THE NAME OF ALLAH, MOST GRACIOUS, MOST MERCIFUL.

Listen to Sura al-A'raf (ch. 7) : verses 16 & 17 :-

"He (Iblis / Shaitan) said: 'Because thou has thrown me out of the way, Lo! I will lie in wait for them on thy straight way: then will I assault them from before them and behind them, from their right, and their left: nor will thou find in most of them gratitude (for thy mercies)'."

How can we keep ourselves from Shaitan's evil ways:-

- A) By reading al-Quraan with understanding regularly.
Sura Muhammad (ch. 47): verse 24
- B) By following the way of our beloved Nabie (S.A.W.).
Sura al-Imran (ch.3): verse 31
- C) By being in the company of the good.
Sura Tauba (ch. 9): verse 119

Remember, Allah (S.W.T.) has given us guidance in the form of the Holy Quraan and the life-style of our Nabie so that we can be strong enough to keep Shaitan from misleading us.

We read in Sura al-Baqara (ch. 2): verse 38:-

"We said: 'Get you down all from here; and if, as is sure, there comes to you guidance from Me, whosoever follows My guidance, on them shall be no fear, nor shall they grieve'."
