

THE PATIENCE OF NABIE AYUB (A.S.)

WITH THE NAME OF ALLAH, MOST GRACIOUS, MOST MERCIFUL.

Nabie Ayub (A.S.) Stands out as an example of patience, trust, and faith in Allah (S.W.T.).

We read in Sura al-Sad (ch. 38): verse 44:-

"... Truly We found him full of patience and constancy. How excellent in Our service ! Ever did he turn (to us)!"

After losing his wealth and children, Nabie Ayub (A.S.) was struck by an awful disease.

He was covered with sores from head to foot, but he remained an obedient servant of our Rabb.

He had to go through a test of extreme suffering.

Throughout his difficulties he never lost faith in Allah (S.W.T.) nor did he ever utter bad word!

One day he cried out to Allah (S.W.T.):-

"...truly distress has seized me, but You are the Most Merciful of those that are merciful."

Sura al-Anbiyaa (ch. 21): verse 83

Our Rabb listened to his prayer:-

"So We listened to him : we removed the distress that was upon him, and we restored his people to him, and doubled their number, --- as a grace from ourselves, and a thing for commemoration, for all who serve us."
