

# DEATH

WITH THE NAME OF ALLAH, MOST GRACIOUS, MOST MERCIFUL.

Our Rabb says in Al-Quraan, Sura al-Imran (Ch 3): verse 185:-

We read in Sura Al-Waqi’a (Ch. 56): verses 60 & 61:-

“We have decreed death to be your common lot, and we are not to be frustrated from changing your forms and creating you (again) in (forms) that you do not know.”
