## PARTS OF A FLOWER

## WITH THE NAME OF ALLAH, MOST GRACIOUS, MOST MERCIFUL.

A flower is made up of a corolla, calyx, stamen and pistil. Allah (S.W.T.) has made the petals of a flower colourful so as to attract insects.

A flower is held together by means of the calyx.

We read in Sura Ya-Sin (ch. 36): verse 36 of pairs in the vegetable kingdom:-

"Glory to Allah, who created in pairs all things that the earth produces, ..."

The male part of a flower is the stamen and the female part is the pistil

The stamen is made up of the anther and the filament.

The pistil is made up of the stigma, style and ovary.

The ovary has seeds which sometimes become fruit.
