Our measuring instruments such as, thermometers, speedometers, burettes, etc. are the results of the materials which our Rabb had provided for our use.

Our Rabb has given us the five senses and the intellect so that we may reach our desired goals through careful observation, thinking and calculation.

We read in Sura al-Sajda (ch. 32): verse 9:-

"But He (Allah) fashioned him (the human being) in due proportion, and breathed into him something of His spirit. And He gave you (the faculties of) hearing and sight and feeling (and understanding): little thanks do you give!"

These gifts must be used to understand our Rabb's plan and purpose of creation in order that we may live in harmony with our environment and our fellow-beings.

We are reminded in Sura al-Jathiya (ch. 45): verse 13:-

"And He has subjected to you, as from Him, all that is in the heavens and the earth: behold, in that are signs indeed for those who think (reflect)."

We find order and harmony in the universe --- so too can order and harmony be brought about in our lives if only we study nature and tune into it!
