

MOUNTAINS

WITH THE NAME OF ALLAH, MOST GRACIOUS, MOST MERCIFUL.

Allah (S.W.T.) has laid mountains on the earth to keep it from shaking.

We read in Sura al-Anbiyya (ch. 21): verse 31:-

“And We have set on the earth mountains standing firm, lest it should shake with them, and we have made therein broad highways (between mountains) for them to pass through: that they may receive guidance.”

Our Rabb has given humans the necessary intellect and the raw materials to build roads through the mountains.

However, as huge and powerful as they are, Allah (S.W.T.) says in Sura Ta-Ha (ch. 20): verses 105 & 106 that he will scatter the mountains as dust:-

“They ask thee concerning the mountains: say, ‘my Rabb will uproot them and scatter them as dust. He will leave them as plains smooth and level.’ ”
